What is SPCC?

SPCC stands for Spill Prevention, Control, and Countermeasure. It's a federal regulation enforced by the EPA that applies to facilities storing significant quantities of oil or fuel.

The goal: prevent discharges into navigable waters or shorelines.

Who Must Comply?

You may be required to maintain an SPCC Plan if your facility:

- Stores 1,320+ gallons of oil/fuel in aboveground containers (each 55 gallons or larger), OR
- Stores 42,000+ gallons in underground tanks not regulated by UST rules

Why It Matters

Non-compliance can result in:

- Fines from regulators Reputation damage
- Environmental citations
- Delays in construction or permitting
